#### Thoughts for the Weeks Ahead

"Routine." Webster's Dictionary describes "routine" as a "more or less unvarying procedure." It can also mean a special series of steps or actions that are common in dance, gymnastics, or sports. But I want us to think for a moment about that first definition: "More or less unvarying procedure."

If you're anything like me, there's a "routine" to most of my weeks. While sometimes routine can seem boring, I suggest that routine is a blessing that gives order to our lives, it gives us a sense of security as it reminds us that we serve an orderly God. Routine allows us to build strong relationships because we know we'll see folks regularly. And it allow us to learn from our past errors and make appropriate corrections. Routine gives stability to our lives.

Routine was built into creation by God. In Genesis 1:14-16 God said, "Let there be lights in the expanse of the heavens to separate the day from the night, and let them be for signs and for seasons and for days and years; and let them be for lights in the expanse of the heavens to give light on the earth." Routine is behind the natural order of the universe ... and it's the basis of the modern scientific method: a consistent and discoverable pattern, or routine, to the world.

I bring this up, for two reasons. First, because the routines of life are also a part of church life. For pastors and church staff, routine means that on Monday morning we need to get ready for next Sunday. And for us as Christians, we can be confident God will care for our church. As Jesus says in Matthew 16:18 – "I will build My church; and the gates of Hades will not overpower it."

As we approach the Summer season, we have a few routine events on the calendar:

- Graduate Recognition Sunday, May 19<sup>th</sup>.
- Lord's Super Service (No Fellowship meal) Sunday, June 2<sup>nd</sup>.
- Vacation Bible School Mon- Friday, June 17-20, 5:30 to 8:00 pm.
- Ameribration 4<sup>th</sup> of July Parade Thursday, July 4<sup>th</sup>.
- Veteran's Fish Fry Thursday, July 11<sup>th</sup>.

Through these routine events we grow closer as a church body and closer to our community.

The second reason I mention routine, is because change is also a routine part of life. While it can be difficult, if we embrace it God uses change to grow our faith. As you know, we're in the search process for a new part-time Music Minister/Director. I am grateful for the years that Stacey Clayton has taken on those important responsibilities. Please pray for our search team as they begin their efforts. God has never left us hanging!

But the change I want to highlight right now is the change in our part-time Youth Ministry Directors. In late 2015, I approached Lance and Trena Gregory about the possibility of leading our youth ministry. They had already been supporting Landon Smith and Adam Smith as they led. In January 2016, they officially came on board and have served FBC for over 8 years. They've given their all to the task and they've touched the lives of many youth from our own church family ... as well as kids who don't have a youth ministry. On Sunday, May 26<sup>th</sup>, we're going to recognize them at the end of the service. Fortunately for FBC, they're staying with us. Lance will continue to serve as a deacon ... and you might see Trena riding one of city fire trucks, as a volunteer fire fighter. They're still serving! Once again, God provided Eric and Heather Littrell to be our new part-time Youth Directors.

As difficult as change can be, it's another opportunity for us to experience the faithfulness of God. He's never failed to meet our needs. That's the kind of routine our God provides for us!
